Blue Raider Basketball Notes

Lindsey Wilson Trails All-Time Series

University of the Cumberlands leads the all-time series with Lindsey Wilson 37-13 since LWC became a four-year institution. Cumberlands owns a 2-1 all-time record in neutral site games and a 2-1 advantage in the Mid-South Conference Tournament, including a 75-56 win last season in Frankfort. The Blue Raiders and Patriots have each won a game in the series in the Frankfort Convention Center. In addition to last season, the two teams met on March 4, 2005 with Lindsey Wilson winning 66-55.

Last Time Out

Lindsey Wilson committed 22 turnovers in a 64-46 loss at St. Catharine College to close out the regular season. Eric McPherson was the lone Blue Raider in double figures with 13 points in the loss. Five Patriots scored in double figures to help Cumberlands outlast Pikeville College 74-69 last Saturday. Travis Harvey led the Patriots with 17 points and 13 rebounds in the win.

Lindsey Wilson - Cumberlands Part I

In what is historically a defensive struggle, Lindsey Wilson and Cumberlands combined to shoot 62.9 percent from the field in a 76-73 Lindsey Wilson win. The Blue Raider win snapped the Cumberlands' six-game winning streak over Lindsey Wilson. Andrija Tintor scored a team-high 18 points while Eric McPherson and Kalen Kimberland added 15 each in a winning effort. Cumberlands' Brandon Russ led all scorers with 22 while Travis Harvey chipped in 17.

Lindsey Wilson - Cumberlands Part II

Cumberlands' Chad Byron hit a three-pointer with 1.3 seconds remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime where the Patriots held off the Blue Raiders 79-74. Lindsey Wilson lost despite shooting 58.1 percent from the field and 50 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Byron and Tanner Jacobs each scored 20 points in the win while Andrija Tintor scored a career-high 27 points in a losing effort.

Moving On Up

Eric McPherson continues to move up the all-time scoring list in Lindsey Wilson history. His 13 points on Saturday moved the Cleveland native into 13th place on the program's all-time scoring list. McPherson enters tonight's game with 939 points in his two years at Lindsey Wilson. He is 23 points away from climbing into 12th place on the all-time list.

Recipe for Success

Despite some struggles this season, Lindsey Wilson's success under coach Paul Peck's revolves around two numbers, 70 and 50. When the Blue Raiders score 70 points in Peck's seven-plus years, Lindsey Wilson is 131-14. Additionally, the Blue Raiders are 73-8 under Peck when they shoot 50 percent or better from the field. This season, LWC is 10-7 when scoring 70 points and 3-1 when shooting 50 percent.

All-Conference Performers

Six players in tonight's game earned all-conference honors this season for their play on the court. Lindsey Wilson's Eric McPherson and Cumberlands' Chad Byron and Brandon Russ earned first team all-conference honors, while Lindsey Wilson's Kalen Kimberland and Andrija Tintor and Cumberlands' Travis Harvey earned honorable mention all-conference honors. Kimberland was named the Mid-South Conference Freshman of the Year and Byron received the Champions of Character award.

Head Coach Paul Peck



Coach Paul Peck enters his eighth season as the Lindsey Wilson College men's basketball coach in 2009-10. He has led the Blue Raiders to a 183-81 record since returning to the program he once coached as a junior college in the late 1970s.

Peck is 419-280 overall entering his 22nd season as a head coach. He is 305-213 against senior college competition during his head coaching career.

The Blue Raiders have reached the NAIA National Tournament five of the seven years under Peck, including a pair of Elite Eight appearances.

Peck has guided the Blue Raiders to a pair of Mid-South Conference Tournament titles and shared the program's only MSC regular season crown in 2004-05.

Peck is a three-time Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year. He shared the 2002-03 and 2003-04 awards and was the lone MSC Coach of the Year in 2004-05.

The Blue Raiders earned the program's first-ever NAIA No. 1 ranking during Peck's tenure in the 2003-04 season after starting the season 22-0. That season, the Blue Raiders won a program-record 33 games.

Prior to coming to Lindsey Wilson, Peck had stints at Cumberland University, Kentucky State University and Panola Junior College. He also served as assistant coach at NCAA institutions Middle Tennessee State University, University of Mississippi and Western Kentucky University.
