Blue Raider Basketball Notes

Lindsey Wilson Travels to MSC Newcomer Rio Grande

Lindsey Wilson begins conference play on the road in an unfamiliar place as the Blue Raiders travel to the newest member of the MSC, University of Rio Grande. The two teams played three times as non-conference foes with the Blue Raiders winning all three, including an 82-57 win in their last visit to Rio Grande on Dec. 30, 2003.

Blue Raiders Cleaning the Glass

In its last two wins, Lindsey Wilson has out-rebounded its opponents by 23.5 rebounds per game. The Blue Raiders out-rebounded Asbury College 52-25 and Marygrove College 57-37.

Opening Mid-South Conference Play

The Blue Raiders are 5-4 all-time in MSC openers. Last season Lindsey Wilson beat Pikeville College 71-67 at Biggers Sports Center to open MSC play. Lindsey Wilson is also 5-4 in MSC road openers. The Blue Raiders defeated Campbellsville University 65-62 in last season's road opener.

Perfect in 2010

Lindsey Wilson is a perfect 2-0 since the New Year with wins over Asbury College and Marygrove College. This month, the Blue Raiders have already doubled their win total from December (1-5).

Three in a Row?

The Blue Raiders look to match to their season-high winning streak with a third consecutive win. Lindsey Wilson won three straight earlier this season with wins over Ohio State University-Neward, Indiana University-Northwest and Talladega College.

Perfect in 2010

Lindsey Wilson is a perfect 2-0 since the New Year with wins over Asbury College and Marygrove College. This month, the Blue Raiders have already doubled their win total from December (1-5).

Long Range Woes

While winning both games in the New Year, the Blue Raiders have struggled from beyond the three-point arc. As a team, Lindsey Wilson has made just seven of 35 threes for 20 percent from deep.

Searching for No. 1

The Blue Raiders enters tonight's game in search of their first road win of the season. Lindsey Wilson is winless in two games on their opponent's home court with losses at Davenport University and Freed Hardeman University.

Bring on the Buckeye State

During coach Paul Peck's tenure, the Blue Raiders have a 21-2 record against teams from the state of Ohio. Only Cedarville University has handed Lindsey Wilson a loss. The Blue Raiders are 6-1 while playing in the Ohio under Peck.

Making the Freebies

Rio Grande is the best in the nation in free throw percentage this season. As a team, the Redstorm is shooting 76.3 percent from the free throw line. Senior P.J. Rase leads the team and the NAIA in the same category making 91.8 percent of his charity tosses.

Contrast in Styles

It is a contrast in styles as the Lindsey Wilson defense will try to contain the high potent Rio Grande offense. Lindsey Wilson ranks 37th in the NAIA in scoring defense, allowing 68.8 points per game. Rio averages 81.6 points per game which ranks 19th in the NAIA.

Head Coach Paul Peck



Coach Paul Peck enters his eighth season as the Lindsey Wilson College men's basketball coach in 2009-10. He has led the Blue Raiders to a 178-72 record since returning to the program he once coached as a junior college in the late 1970s.

Peck is 414-271 overall entering his 22nd season as a head coach. He is 300-204 against senior college competition during his head coaching career.

The Blue Raiders have reached the NAIA National Tournament five of the seven years under Peck, including a pair of Elite Eight appearances.

Peck has guided the Blue Raiders to a pair of Mid-South Conference Tournament titles and shared the program's only MSC regular season crown in 2004-05.

Peck is a three-time Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year. He shared the 2002-03 and 2003-04 awards and was the lone MSC Coach of the Year in 2004-05.

The Blue Raiders earned the program's first-ever NAIA No. 1 ranking during Peck's tenure in the 2003-04 season after starting the season 22-0. That season, the Blue Raiders won a program-record 33 games.

Prior to coming to Lindsey Wilson, Peck had stints at Cumberland University, Kentucky State University and Panola Junior College. He also served as assistant coach at NCAA institutions Middle Tennessee State University, University of Mississippi and Western Kentucky University.
