Blue Raider Basketball Notes

Lindsey Wilson Leads All-Time Series

Lindsey Wilson leads the all-time series with St. Catharine 2-0 since LWC became a four-year institution. The Blue Raiders swept St. Catharine last season in the Patriots' debut season in the Mid-South Conference. The Blue Raiders are 1-0 against the Patriots at Biggers Sports Center.

Last Time Out

On Monday, the Blue Raiders struggled on both ends of the court in a 69-41 loss at Georgetown College. Lindsey Wilson shot just 37.1 percent (13-of-35) from the field, including making just one of its 14 attempts for beyond the three-point arc. St. Catharine upset its second straight nationally ranked opponent winning at Campbellsville University 56-53.

Breaking a Tie

Lindsey Wilson and St. Catharine enter tonight's game tied for fourth in the MSC with a 3-3 record. Both teams are two games behind conference-leading Pikeville College. Tonight's game also concludes the first half of the conference schedule.

No Place Like Home

After playing four of their first six conference games on the road, the Blue Raiders play the first of three straight conference games tonight against St. Catharine. Lindsey Wilson hosts Pikeville on Saturday and University of Rio Grande next Thursday.

Moving On Up

Eric McPherson continues to move up the all-time scoring list in Lindsey Wilson history. His six points on Thursday moved the Cleveland native within 11 points of taking over the 16th place on the program's all-time scoring list. McPherson enters today's game with 844 points in his two years at Lindsey Wilson.

Love to See SCC

Eric McPherson loves looking over and seeing St. Catharine on the opposing bench. In two games last season against the Patriots, McPherson averaged 22 points and 4.5 rebounds. He shot 66.7 percent (12-of-18) from the field and connected on 17 for 18 (94.4 percent) from the free throw line.

Recipe for Success

Despite some struggles this season, Lindsey Wilson's success under coach Paul Peck's revolves around two numbers, 70 and 50. When the Blue Raiders score 70 points in Peck's seven-plus years, Lindsey Wilson is 131-12. Additionally, the Blue Raiders are 73-7 under Peck when they shoot 50 percent or better from the field. This season, LWC is 9-5 when scoring 70 points and 3-0 when shooting 50 percent.

Turning Things Around

After struggling last season to a 5-24 record, including 1-11 in its Mid-South Conference debut, St. Catharine is among the conference's best teams with a 15-7 record and 3-3 in MSC play. This season, the Patriots have beaten four nationally ranked teams, including Georgetown and Campbellsville in their last two games.

Post-It

St. Catharine's post play has been exceptional this season. The combination of Ervin Williams and Arthur Latham gives the Patriots arguably the best 1-2 interior punch in the MSC this season. Williams leads the team in scoring (16.5 points per game) and rebounding (6.8) and Latham is on Williams' heels averaging 16.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per game.

Head Coach Paul Peck



Coach Paul Peck enters his eighth season as the Lindsey Wilson College men's basketball coach in 2009-10. He has led the Blue Raiders to a 181-75 record since returning to the program he once coached as a junior college in the late 1970s.

Peck is 417-274 overall entering his 22nd season as a head coach. He is 303-207 against senior college competition during his head coaching career.

The Blue Raiders have reached the NAIA National Tournament five of the seven years under Peck, including a pair of Elite Eight appearances.

Peck has guided the Blue Raiders to a pair of Mid-South Conference Tournament titles and shared the program's only MSC regular season crown in 2004-05.

Peck is a three-time Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year. He shared the 2002-03 and 2003-04 awards and was the lone MSC Coach of the Year in 2004-05.

The Blue Raiders earned the program's first-ever NAIA No. 1 ranking during Peck's tenure in the 2003-04 season after starting the season 22-0. That season, the Blue Raiders won a program-record 33 games.

Prior to coming to Lindsey Wilson, Peck had stints at Cumberland University, Kentucky State University and Panola Junior College. He also served as assistant coach at NCAA institutions Middle Tennessee State University, University of Mississippi and Western Kentucky University.
