## Blue Raider Basketball Notes

### Lindsey Wilson-Campbellsville All-Time Series

Lindsey Wilson trails the all-time series 22-29, including 8-16 at the Powell Athletic Center. The Tigers have won three straight in the series, including a 69-61 overtime win over Jan. 31.

### Lindsey Wilson Last Time Out

The Blue Raiders trailed just once in the game and scored the final five points to beat No. 8-ranked Georgetown College 63-59 last Saturday. The Blue Raider defense limited Georgetown to three for 18 behind the three-point arc and forced the Tigers into 21 turnovers in the win. Brandon Clemons scored 16 and Justin Archie added 15 points in the win. Archie also recorded a career-high six steals.

### Campbellsville Last Time Out

Campbellsville narrowly missed upsetting No. 22-ranked St. Catharine College last Saturday. The Tigers held the visiting Patriots to just 19 percent shooting from beyond the three-point arc, but was out-rebounded 53-29 in the loss. Caleb Harris led four Tigers in double figures with 23 points.

### Lindsey Wilson-Campbellsville First Meeting

Campbellsville scored the first 10 points of the overtime as the Tigers never trailed in the extra period en route to a 69-61 overtime win at Biggers Sports Center. The Tigers limited Lindsey Wilson to just 2-for-21 shooting from deep while making 45.5 percent (10-of-22) of their three's. JaVaughn Espritt led the Tigers with 13 points and 12 rebounds.

### Leader of the Pack

Lindsey Wilson leads the Mid-South Conference in a pair of statistical categories. The Blue Raiders lead the conference and is 12th in the NAIA in scoring defense (64.4) and tops in the MSC and 17th in the NAIA in free throw percentage (71.2).

### The Best and the Worst

Campbellsville leads the Mid-South Conference in three-point field goal defense as the Tigers hold their opponents to just 27.3 percent shooting from deep. The Tigers are last in the MSC in overall field goal percentage making 41.8 percent of their shots and last in rebounding averaging 35.3 rebounds per game.

### Recipe for Success

Lindsey Wilson's success under coach Paul Peck revolves around two numbers, 70 and 50. When the Blue Raiders score 70 points in Peck's eight-plus years, Lindsey Wilson is 147-16. Additionally, the Blue Raiders are 77-8 under Peck when they shoot 50 percent or better from the field. This season, LWC is 13-1 when scoring 70 points -- the lone loss came to Pikeville -- and 4-0 when shooting 50 percent.

### Recipe for Success -- Part II

Lindsey Wilson is 10-0 this season when the Blue Raiders shoot a higher percentage from the field than their opponents and when they hit at least 35 percent of its three-pointers.

### Streaking Lately

In the last four wins, Chase Spreen is averaging 17 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while Justin Archie is averaging 14 points, 4.5 assists and 3.8 steals per game. Spreen (25) and Archie (19) scored career-highs at West Virginia Tech on Feb. 10.

### Prince of Thieves

Lindsey Wilson's Justin Archie leads the Mid-South Conference and is second in the NAIA in steals this season averaging 2.7 steals per game.

## Head Coach Paul Peck



Coach Paul Peck enters his ninth season as the Lindsey Wilson College men's basketball coach in 2010-11. He has led the Blue Raiders to a 203-89 record since returning to the program he once coached as a junior college in the late 1970s.

Peck is 439-288 overall entering his 23rd season as a head coach. He is 325-221 against senior college competition during his head coaching career.

The Blue Raiders have reached the NAIA National Tournament five of the eight years under Peck, including a pair of Elite Eight appearances.

Peck has guided the Blue Raiders to a pair of Mid-South Conference Tournament titles and shared the program's only MSC regular-season crown in 2004-05.

Peck is a three-time Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year. He shared the 2002-03 and 2003-04 awards and was the lone MSC Coach of the Year in 2004-05.

The Blue Raiders earned the program's first-ever NAIA No. 1 ranking during Peck's tenure in the 2003-04 season after starting the season 22-0. That season, the Blue Raiders won a program-record 33 games.

Prior to coming to Lindsey Wilson, Peck had stints at Cumberland University, Kentucky State University and Panola Junior College. He also served as assistant coach at NCAA institutions Middle Tennessee State University, University of Mississippi and Western Kentucky University.
