## Blue Raider Basketball Notes

### Lindsey Wilson-Shawnee State All-Time Series

Lindsey Wilson leads the all-time series 3-1. Thursday's meeting is the first-ever meeting at Biggers Sports Center. Lindsey Wilson has won three straight in the series, including a 51-44 win earlier this season at Shawnee State.

### Lindsey Wilson Last Time Out

Lindsey Wilson limited Rio Grande to just 37.7 percent shooting while forcing the RedStorm into 20 turnovers in a 72-69 win on the road last Saturday. Lindsey Wilson's Charles Bakers led the Blue Raiders with 18 points while Chase Spreen added 16 points.

### Shawnee State Last Time Out

Shawnee State committed 27 turnovers in a 106-68 loss at Georgetown College last Saturday. The Bears lost despite shooting nearly 52 percent from the field, including better than 47 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Tyler Boyles led the Bears with 23 points.

### Lindsey Wilson-Shawnee State First Meeting

The Blue Raiders held Shawnee State to a season-low 44 points in a 51-44 win in Portsmouth, Ohio on Jan. 13. The Lindsey Wilson defense held the Bears to just 29.8 percent (17-of-57) shooting, including 3-for-17 (17.6 percent) from beyond the three-point arc.

### Leader of the Pack

Lindsey Wilson leads the Mid-South Conference in a pair of statistical categories. The Blue Raiders lead the conference and is 11th in the NAIA in scoring defense (64.2) and tops in the MSC and 16th in the NAIA in free throw percentage (71.4).

### Recipe for Success

Lindsey Wilson's success under coach Paul Peck revolves around two numbers, 70 and 50. When the Blue Raiders score 70 points in Peck's eight-plus years, Lindsey Wilson is 146-16. Additionally, the Blue Raiders are 77-8 under Peck when they shoot 50 percent or better from the field. This season, LWC is 12-1 when scoring 70 points -- the lone loss came to Pikeville -- and 4-0 when shooting 50 percent.

### Recipe for Success -- Part II

Lindsey Wilson is 10-0 this season when the Blue Raiders shoot a higher percentage from the field than their opponents.

### Back to Winning Ways

Following a season-long three-game losing streak entering play last week, the Blue Raiders enter Thursday's game on a two-game winning streak.

### Last Week's Dynamic Duo

Lindsey Wilson's Chase Spreen and Justin Archie produced terrific games last week in road wins over West Virginia Tech and Rio Grande. Spreen averaged 20.5 points over the two games, including a career-high 25 points in the Tech win, while Archie averaged 16 points and five assists per game in the wins. Archie also set a career-high last Thursday with 19 points.

### Prince of Thieves

Lindsey Wilson's Justin Archie leads the Mid-South Conference and is sixth in the NAIA in steals this season averaging 2.6 steals per game.

### Peck Hits 200 Wins at Lindsey Wilson

Lindsey Wilson head coach Paul Peck picked up his 200th career win last Thursday as the Blue Raiders head man. Peck is 201-89 all-time as the Blue Raiders' head coach. He is Lindsey Wilson's all-time winningest men's basketball coach.

## Head Coach Paul Peck



Coach Paul Peck enters his ninth season as the Lindsey Wilson College men's basketball coach in 2010-11. He has led the Blue Raiders to a 201-89 record since returning to the program he once coached as a junior college in the late 1970s.

Peck is 437-288 overall entering his 23rd season as a head coach. He is 323-221 against senior college competition during his head coaching career.

The Blue Raiders have reached the NAIA National Tournament five of the eight years under Peck, including a pair of Elite Eight appearances.

Peck has guided the Blue Raiders to a pair of Mid-South Conference Tournament titles and shared the program's only MSC regular-season crown in 2004-05.

Peck is a three-time Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year. He shared the 2002-03 and 2003-04 awards and was the lone MSC Coach of the Year in 2004-05.

The Blue Raiders earned the program's first-ever NAIA No. 1 ranking during Peck's tenure in the 2003-04 season after starting the season 22-0. That season, the Blue Raiders won a program-record 33 games.

Prior to coming to Lindsey Wilson, Peck had stints at Cumberland University, Kentucky State University and Panola Junior College. He also served as assistant coach at NCAA institutions Middle Tennessee State University, University of Mississippi and Western Kentucky University.
