Blue Raider Basketball Notes

Lindsey Wilson-West Virginia Tech All-Time Series

Tonight's game is the 10th in the all-time series between Lindsey Wilson and West Virginia University Tech. Lindsey Wilson leads the all-time series 6-3, but trail the series 1-3 in Montgomery. The Blue Raiders have won three straight in the series, including an 80-73 win in Columbia on Jan. 6.

Lindsey Wilson Last Time Out

Lindsey Wilson lost to University of the Cumberlands 60-42 last Saturday after shooting 32.7 percent from the field, including four for 17 beyond the three-point arc. The Blue Raiders were also out-rebounded 40-15 in the game. The 42 points were a season-low for the Blue Raiders this season.

West Virginia Tech Last Time Out

West Virginia Tech scored 55 second half points to win at Campbellsville 83-74 last Saturday. The Golden Bears limited Campbellsville to just 30.8 percent shooting from the field and won the rebounding battle 54-35.

Contrast of Styles

Lindsey Wilson leads the MSC in scoring defense allowing its opponents to average 64.3 points per game. West Virginia Tech is third in the conference averaging 89.9 points per game. The Golden Bears have never scored more than 72 points against the Blue Raiders in the all-time series.

Leader of the Pack

Lindsey Wilson leads the Mid-South Conference in a pair of statistical categories. The Blue Raiders lead the conference and is 11th in the NAIA in scoring defense (64.3) and tops in the MSC and 21st in the NAIA in free throw percentage (70.7).

Recipe for Success

Lindsey Wilson's success under coach Paul Peck revolves around two numbers, 70 and 50. When the Blue Raiders score 70 points in Peck's eight-plus years, Lindsey Wilson is 145-16. Additionally, the Blue Raiders are 77-8 under Peck when they shoot 50 percent or better from the field. This season, LWC is 11-1 when scoring 70 points -- the lone loss came to Pikeville -- and 4-0 when shooting 50 percent.

Shooting Woes in Losses

Lindsey Wilson is shooting just 36.2 percent from the field in its eight losses this season, including 22.4 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Conversely, the Blue Raiders are making 47.7 percent of their shots and 35.4 percent of their three pointers in their 15 wins.

Three-Point Struggles

The Blue Raiders have made just 24 of their last 118 three-point attempts over the last six games. For the season, Lindsey Wilson is shooting 31.3 percent from deep.

Peck Nears Win 200 at Lindsey Wilson

While Lindsey Wilson head coach Paul Peck has 435 wins in his coaching career, he is nearing a milestone for his tenure with the Blue Raiders. Peck is one win from 200 in his Lindsey Wilson coaching career entering tonight's game. Peck is 199-89 all-time as the Blue Raiders' head coach.

Last Season Matched

The Blue Raiders won their 15th game of the season on Jan. 27 matching last season's win total. The 2009-10 team finished 15-16. The win -- against a Mid-South Conference foe -- is the sixth this season compared to just five in 2009-10.

Head Coach Paul Peck



Coach Paul Peck enters his ninth season as the Lindsey Wilson College men's basketball coach in 2010-11. He has led the Blue Raiders to a 199-89 record since returning to the program he once coached as a junior college in the late 1970s.

Peck is 435-288 overall entering his 23rd season as a head coach. He is 321-221 against senior college competition during his head coaching career.

The Blue Raiders have reached the NAIA National Tournament five of the eight years under Peck, including a pair of Elite Eight appearances.

Peck has guided the Blue Raiders to a pair of Mid-South Conference Tournament titles and shared the program's only MSC regular-season crown in 2004-05.

Peck is a three-time Mid-South Conference Coach of the Year. He shared the 2002-03 and 2003-04 awards and was the lone MSC Coach of the Year in 2004-05.

The Blue Raiders earned the program's first-ever NAIA No. 1 ranking during Peck's tenure in the 2003-04 season after starting the season 22-0. That season, the Blue Raiders won a program-record 33 games.

Prior to coming to Lindsey Wilson, Peck had stints at Cumberland University, Kentucky State University and Panola Junior College. He also served as assistant coach at NCAA institutions Middle Tennessee State University, University of Mississippi and Western Kentucky University.
